**VEXATIOUS LITIGANT ORDER**

Before Mr. Sengupta is able to serve further complaints on the University of Alaska, he must petition for leave to file the complaint.

Leave will only be granted if:

- a. The complaint does not restate a cause of action that has already been asserted or could have been asserted in a prior case against the same parties;
- b. The complaint is definite, detailed, and legally sufficient to survive a motion to dismiss; and
- c. Unless a stay of execution is in place, Mr. Sengupta has submitted proof that he has paid any court-ordered sanctions and awards of

attorney fees that he owes under existing judgments and orders to defendants named in the new complaint.

If Mr. Sengupta attempts to file a complaint that does not comply with the above procedures, the complaint will not be accepted by the court and the defendant(s) will not be required to answer or respond in any way. If filed, a complaint that does not comply with the above procedures may be dismissed by the court sua sponte.
