PROCEEDINGS: **ORDER FROM CHAMBERS**

In the order at docket 102, the court held that plaintiffs were entitled to recover the reasonable expenses of bringing their successful motion to compel discovery pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 37(a) (5) (A). Plaintiffs were directed to file a properly supported request and defendant was afforded an opportunity to oppose the amount requested, but no further opportunity to oppose entitlement to reasonable expenses.

Plaintiffs filed their motion for reasonable expenses at docket 103. The time for responding has run and defendant has not responded. Upon examination, the request for \$2,300 is found to be adequately supported and the amount requested is found to be reasonable. Accordingly, the motion at docket 103 is GRANTED as follows: Defendant shall pay plaintiffs' counsel the sum of \$2,300 within 45 days from the date of this order.
